April 3, 2017

Dallas Cowboys Head Coach Jason Garrett will kick-off the initiative by reading the first chapter of *The Lemonade War* by Jacqueline Davies via web video.

Students get to keep the books, available in English and Spanish, and are encouraged to read at home with their families.

Evan and his sister Jessie usually get along just fine, until he finds out that she's skipping third grade. That means she'll be in his fourth grade class next year, showing him up every day with her perfect grades.
