Ways to help your child succeed in Reading:



Before your child reads:

- Help your child set aside a special time for reading every day.
- Make sure they have a quiet place to read every day.

While your child reads:

- Your child can read to you or you can take turns reading to your child. Your child can also practice reading to a younger brother or sister.

After your child reads:

- Ask your child questions about what they read. What was the main idea? What was the book mainly about? What was your favorite part of the book? Describe one of the characters in the book.
