

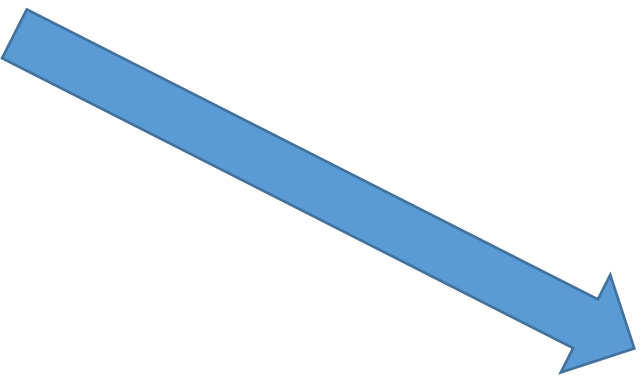

Front Page

- Core Classes
 - You need to circle the appropriate English, Math, Science, and Social Studies class.
 - You need 4 English, 4 Math (including Algebra 1 and Geometry), 4 Sciences (including Biology and a lab based science), and 4 Social Studies
- Foreign Language
 - You need 2 credits of the same language to graduate.
 - You need to circle (if listed) your next foreign language course
 - If your foreign language course is not listed, write in your course.
- Fine Arts
 - You need 1 credit to graduate.
 - Circle the course you would like to take.
 - Or leave it blank if you already have your Fine Art credit and do not want to take any more Fine Art classes.
- Physical Education
 - You need 1 credit to graduate.
 - Circle the course you would like to take.
 - Or leave it blank if you already have your PE credit and do not want to take any more Physical Education classes..
- Dual Credit Requirement
 - You have to be a peer coach 1 year if you take dual credit classes.
 - Please mark peer coach or bilingual peer coach
 - If you are not a dual credit student, leave this area blank.

Back Page

- CTE Endorsement
 - Circle your endorsement area (Business and Industry, Arts and Humanities, Public Service, STEM, or Multidisciplinary)
 - Write in your cluster (ex: Construction)
 - If you are not sure, look at the CTE spreadsheet
- Classes needed under Endorsement and Cluster
 - Look at the CTE spreadsheet
 - Write in the next class you need
 - Example: Cluster is Welding
 - You already have taken Business Information Management and Intro to Welding
 - You would write in Welding 1 for your next course
- Work Program
 - Juniors and Seniors only
 - Student must have a job or they will be removed from the program.
 - You will have one period of career prep and may have up to 3 periods of work.
- Electives and Alternative Electives
 - You need to list 2 electives that you would like.
 - Also list 2 alternative electives that you would like in case your classes do not work.
- Seniors 2019-2020 Only
 - Flex Scheduling
 - You must be in good standing for graduation and passed all EOCs except US History.
 - List the amount of periods you would like to flex (1, 2, or 3)

Additional Information

- You can access all course descriptions by using the link on the registration instructions
- Registration for PAP/AP classes require a 1st semester average of at least an 80 in a PAP/AP course and/or a teacher signature.
- Current DC students and New DC Students
 - You must submit your permit to register from Mrs. Franklin. Otherwise you will not be enrolled in DC courses.
- Higher Start Students
 - You will need to bring your PGP for from Mrs. Franklin. Otherwise you will not be enrolled in DC courses.
